

# Enabling Blocked Content in Blackboard

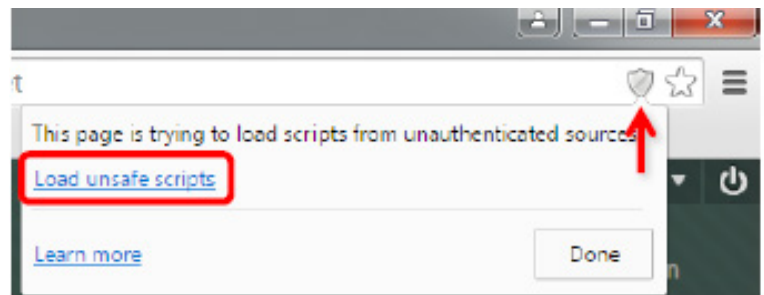
## How to Enable Blocked Content

You may notice that Blackboard blocks some of the embedded content (audio and video files) in your courses. That is because Blackboard is a secure environment. While we recommend Google Chrome, use the instructions below for your specific browser to enable this “unsecure” content.



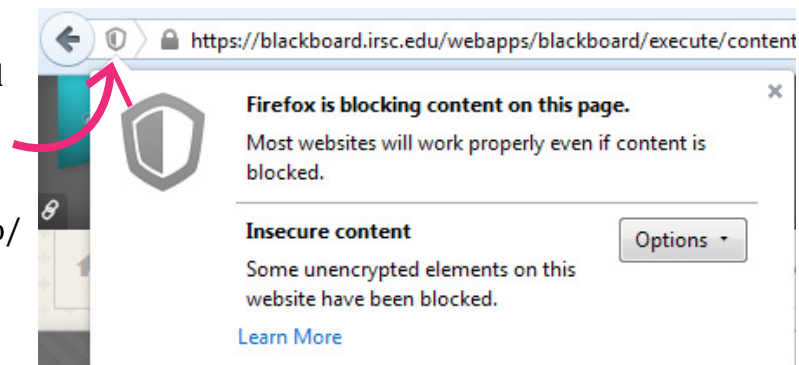
### Google Chrome

1. In the address bar, click on the **shield icon** in the upper right-hand corner.
2. Next, click on the **Load unsafe scripts** link.
3. Blackboard will refresh and the audio/video should now play properly.



### Mozilla Firefox

1. In the address bar, click on the **shield icon** in the upper left-hand corner.
2. Next, click on the **Options** button.
3. Select **Disable Protection for now**.
4. Blackboard will refresh and the audio/video should now play properly.



### Internet Explorer

1. A pop-up will appear at the bottom of the web page. Click **Show all content**.
2. Blackboard will refresh and the audio/video should now play properly.
